

# ANNUAL FAMILY MEDICINE TEACHERS MEETING

## 27 October 2018

Department of Family Medicine and Primary Care hosted the Annual Family Medicine Teachers' Meeting on 27 October, 2018. The Department invited HKCFP Visiting Professor, Professor Martin Dawes from Department of Family Practice, The University of British Columbia, to deliver a keynote speech on "Teaching Medical Students in Family Practice: the one-minute preceptor and other tools" as one of the highlights of the meeting. Following the keynote speech, Dr Julie Chen, Assistant Dean (Learner Wellbeing), gave a presentation on "CARE: Re-conceptualizing our expectations of medical students" and Dr Weng Chin, Chief of Undergraduate Education, shared with teachers on the updates and feedbacks on Family Medicine undergraduate teaching.
